

**Mills High School Music Program Field Trip itinerary  
Disneyland Performance Workshops, Anaheim, CA  
March 11 – 14, 2022**

**It is extremely important not to be late.**

**Consequence of being late** to any announced meeting time is:

- First offense – spend an hour in detention with Mr. G.
- Second offense – to be determined by Mr. G on a case by case basis

Meeting spot at park: Immediately inside the Disneyland gates in front of the Mickey Mouse lawn decoration (“X” marks the spot):



<b>Friday, March 11</b>	<b>“It’s all about that bus, ‘bout that bus, ‘bout that bus!”</b>
6:30 am	Call time, meet in the music room. Bring suitcase (labeled) and instrument (labeled) (flutes and clarinets – can be kept with you). Meet up with your chaperone before proceeding to the bus as directed. Be prompt so we can get the bus loaded and we depart on time.
7:00 am	Bus departs
12:30 pm	Rest/M meal Stop (packed lunch or fast food – on your own). Return to bus at the instructed time.
~4:00 pm	Arrive at hotel Embassy Suites - 3100 E. Frontera St. Anaheim CA 92806 Student activity in the ballroom, retrieve keys and room assignments from chaperones afterwards and go to rooms
5:30 pm	Pizza dinner at the hotel; will need chaperones to help serve
7:00 pm	Senior Talk -- Hotel Ballroom
9:30 pm	Back in hotel rooms, get ready for bed
10:00 pm	Lights Out! Chaperone meeting

<b>Saturday, March 12</b>	<b>Disneyland &amp; California Adventure Parks</b>
6:30 am	“Wake up, get out of bed, drag a comb through your head!”
7:00 am	Breakfast at hotel (opens at 7am; all you can eat) Chaperones - get park tickets and meal cards from Ahgee; consider taking photos of the ticket barcodes, then distribute to students at your leisure.
7:45 am	Load Buses
8:00 am	Bus departs for Disneyland & California Adventure Parks Reservations at Disneyland first. Park hopping after 1pm. Students must inform their chaperone when they intend to park hop.
11:30 am	<b>Choir students</b> and 3 chaperones meet near the exit gates of Disneyland. Location TBA by Mr. G. BE ON TIME! Walk to Imagination Campus Studios.
12:00 pm	<b>CHOIR</b> Soundtrack Recording Workshop - group migrate and be at Downtown Disney West End at 12:00 noon to meet guest Talent Coordinator, session starts 12:30pm. <i>No Cameras</i>
2:00 pm	Choir session finished, students may return to the parks. Inform their chaperones which park you are going to. Chaperones attending the workshop confirm there are no students traveling alone to meet up with their friends.
~6:00 pm	Dinner (\$15 meal card)
9:00 pm	Meet to leave Disney Parks. Meet in front of Mickey Mouse flower design at Carnation Square. Will try to watch fireworks unless a large crowd starts moving towards the shuttle station – then may move to take shuttle for Toy Story parking lot before the firework ends. (Fireworks show is 9-9:10p, and we need to beat the bulk of the crowd to the shuttle)
10:00 pm	Students on the bus, depart for the hotel ( <b>VERY IMPORTANT</b> for the bus driver to be back at the hotel by 10:15pm. Drivers must have 8 hours rest time and be back on duty by 7:45am. We must leave by 8:15am the next day to get to our workshops on time.)
11:00 pm	Lights Out! <b>Daylight Savings begins</b> overnight. Remember to “Spring Forward” with your clocks and watches. Chaperone meeting after students are confirmed in their rooms.
<b>Sunday, March 13</b>	<b>Disneyland &amp; California Adventure Parks</b>
7:00 am	“Wake up, get out of bed, drag a comb through your head!”
7:30 am	Breakfast at hotel (all you can eat)
8:15 am	Board buses to Disneyland & California Adventure Parks. All instruments loaded onto Bus #1 (cargo section. not in seating area)
8:30 am	Bus departure
~9:00 am	Bus drop off at Downtown Disney West End. All students except band members can continue to Disneyland. Leave instruments on the bus.

9:15 am **BAND** students – Mr. G and 6 chaperones meet with guest Talent Coordinator for 10am recording session. Bus with instruments will be near the studio for pick-up. *No cameras during workshop.*

11:00 am Lunch – Orchestra students should eat before recording session

11:30 am Band recording session over. Band students can return to Disneyland after they load their instruments back onto the bus.  
Band students to text chaperones to inform them they're returning to the park.  
Chaperones attending the workshop confirm there are no students traveling alone to meet up with their friends.

12:00 pm **ORCHESTRA** students – meet Mr. G and 3 chaperones near exit gates of Disneyland. Same location announced by Mr. G the day before. Group to proceed to Imagination Campus recording studios, located in Downtown Disney West End.

12:30 pm Meet with guest Talent Coordinator for a session start at 1pm. *No cameras*

3:00 pm Orchestra session over, students hustle to load instruments into the bus. **This needs to be done quickly** so drivers can leave ASAP for their 8 hours required rest before returning to pick everybody up at 11:45pm). Orchestra students contact their chaperones to inform which park they are going back to.  
Chaperones attending the workshop confirm there are no students traveling alone to meet up with their friends.

~6:00 pm Dinner (\$15 meal card)

10:45 pm Students **MUST** enter Disneyland by this time in order to be able to meet at 11:15pm inside the park (Gates into Disneyland will close at 11pm!)

11:15 pm Disneyland closes, meet with group near Mickey Mouse decoration in Carnation Square; Take shuttle for Toy Story Lot

11:50 pm Bus arrives, board, and depart for hotel

12:30 am Lights out!

7:30 am Breakfast at hotel (all you can eat)
